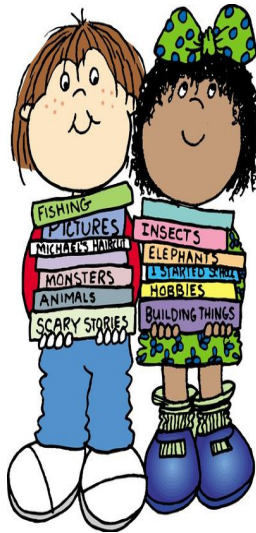




Centre School's Summer Reading Suggestions Entering Grade 1
