Students will be requested to share their understanding of books read, according to individual instructors' requirements. If your summer reading goes beyond what is listed here, please give other titles on the verification form. It is our sincere desire that you enjoy this opportunity.

B/C 1 biography, non-fiction or fiction book of at least 250 pages OR 3 articles from one or more magazines: **one book/article set required.**

H/A *Eye of the Needle* (fiction) by Ken Follett AND 1 non-fiction book or biography of at least 250 pages: **2 bks req.**

World Lit. AP *Reading in the Dark* by Seamus Deane AND *The Old Man Who Read Love Stories* by Luis Sepulveda AND *The Handmaid's Tale* by Margaret Atwood: **3 books required.** (additional verification by teacher)

World Hist. AP *Ishmael* by Daniel Quinn (fiction) AND *Guns, Germs and Steel: The Fates of Human Societies* by Jared Diamond (non-fiction): **2 books required.** (additional verification by teacher)
