

What are Downloadable Audiobooks?

Downloadable audiobooks are an exciting media available to you from the Lane Memorial Library's website. They are both iPod and WMA compatible so they will play on just about any platform. WMA plays on PC/WMA player/iPod/CD, but not on a Mac or some MP3 players. You can check out and download audiobooks from the comfort of your own home!

Once you've downloaded the book you may then listen to it on your PC, Mac, iPod, or MP3 player. Some books can even be burned to CD.

When the books are due (after one week) they will check back in automatically.

To access downloadable audiobooks from the website you will need

-A Lane Memorial Library card

-Access to the Internet

-Free software for the computer available from the downloadable audiobook site

*Please note that digital downloads can be enjoyed at home, at work, or when you travel, but are not for use on library computers. Books are provided by the NH State Library and the Lane Memorial Library.

Some Things to Remember

- Before purchasing a digital audio player be sure to click on the Supported Portable Audio Devices link on the bottom of the left hand menu from the Download Audiobook website.
- Items added to the cart will disappear after 60 minutes. You may have five items in your cart at one time but can only have three books checked out at any one time.
- If you are looking to check out a book that can be burned to CD be sure to look for the burn to CD Image next to the title of the book.
- The downloadable audiobooks check themselves back in automatically after one week. You do not have to do anything to check in the item. Items cannot be returned early due to restrictions from the publishers.
- If an item has been checked out by another you can place a hold for the item. You will be notified by e-mail with a link to check out the item and must do so within two days of the e-mail being sent.
- To cancel a hold, from any page choose the 'My Account' button. Log in to your account. Click the 'My Holds' link. The list of titles that you have currently placed on hold is displayed. Click the 'Remove' link next to the title in which you are no longer interested.
- WMA – 2700+ titles / MP3 – 200+ titles

How do I check out a downloadable audiobook?

1. Go to www.hampton.lib.nh.us and click on "Download Me" from the middle column.
2. Once on the downloadable audiobook site, click on the "Audio Software" link from the left-hand menu. Click on the OverDrive Media Console icon and then click on the icon again to install the software. Be sure to install the Windows Media Player Security Upgrade when prompted. (This needs to be done only once for each PC you use to download.)
3. You are now ready to check out and download audiobooks from OverDrive site. Click on a book title you would like to check out and then click on the "Add to cart" link on the right side of the screen just under where it says "Format Information". You may check out three books at one time.
4. Click on the "Proceed to Checkout" link.
5. You must now enter your Lane Memorial Library card number (no spaces).
6. You will see some important notes regarding your digital account. You must click on "Confirm check out" to continue.
7. Click on the "Download" button to download the title.

How do I download and listen to my audiobook?

1. After clicking on the "download" button you will be prompted with a dialog box. Click on "OK". Do not attempt to save the book anywhere other than the default setting (which is My Documents/My Media.)
2. You will then be prompted to select how many parts you wish to download at this time. If you are on a dial-up you may wish to just select one or two parts. If you are on a faster connection choose all parts. Click "OK".
3. Your book will begin downloading into the OverDrive Media Console. Once the download is complete you are ready to begin listening.
4. Depending on the title you have up to three ways to choose to listen to the title. If you want to listen on your PC, click on "Play" on the OverDrive Media Console. This will bring up the OverDrive Media Explorer and the book will instantly begin playing. You may also choose to download the title to a digital audio player or in some cases burn it to a CD.
5. To transfer to a digital audio player, connect your portable player to your computer. In OverDrive Media Console, highlight the title you wish to transfer and click the "Transfer" button. The OverDrive Media Console Transfer Wizard is displayed. Verify that the correct title is displayed on the first screen of the Transfer Wizard and click "Next".

6. In the "Confirm" dialog box, select the Parts you want to transfer by checking the boxes next to the part name. Click "Next."
7. To burn a book to CD place a CD-R into your recordable CD drive. (Eraseable CDs, i.e. CD-RW, will not work.) In the OverDrive Media console, highlight the title you wish to burn and click the "Burn" button. The OverDrive Media Console Burn Wizard is activated. Verify that the correct title is displayed on the first screen of the Burn Wizard and click "Next".
8. In the "Confirm" dialog box, select the Parts you want to burn by checking the boxes next to the Part names. Click "Next" to begin burning the files to CD. The "Progress" screen is displayed.
9. If you have selected more than one Part to burn to CD, the Burn Wizard will prompt you to enter a new CD as each Part finishes burning. Each part fits on one CD. When the file transfer is complete, the Burn Wizard displays a "success" message.
10. Books will check out for one week. If you have burned your book to a CD you will be able to listen to it once the week is over. In most cases you will also be able to continue to listen to it on your digital audio player. But you will no longer be able to listen to it via OverDrive Media Console. You will need to renew the item.
11. To renew you will need to add the item to your cart and then check it out. Click on download. This will download the digital rights for the book. If you didn't delete the book from your PC or Mac then you will not have to download the parts again.
