Grant awarded for land purchase

NEWFIELDS | State officials have announced a

\$50,000 grant to help purchase the 329-acre Piscassic Greenway in Newfields. The Piscassic Greenway

is the largest block of undeveloped land in Newfields and will help to link more than 2,600 acres of previously conserved land in Newfields, Newmarket, Exeter and Epping.

US Senators Judd Gregg and John Sununu, along with Congressman Jeb Bradley announced the grant will be awarded to the Piscassic Greenway Conservation Initiative through the U.S. Fish and Wildlife's North American Wetlands Conservation Council.

Located along the Piscassic River, the greenway is

home to wetlands and habitats for migratory birds and other wildlife. The Rockingham Land Trust will manage 318 acres of the greenway; the remaining 11 acres will remain privately owned.

The Piscassic Greenway Conservation Initiative is a partnership between the town of Newfields, the state Department of Environmental Services, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's Coastal and Estuarine Land Conservation Program, Newbury North Development and the Trust for Public Land.

HAMPTON | After dismantling and relocating an 18th century barn from its previous location on Drake-side Road to the grounds of the Tuck Museum, the Hampton Historical Society needs to raise the funds necessary to fully restore the historical structure.

Members of the Seacoast area community are invited to contribute much-needed donations to help bring the HHS's barn project to its completion. Contributions of any amount will be gratefully accepted; those totaling more than \$100 will be recognized on a permanent

plaque which will be on display in the barn.

ROLL CALL ROUND UP

HOUSE

(A) DROWNING ANIMALS ISN'T CRUEL | SB351 would make it a felony to drown an animal under the animal cruelty statute. Supporters said that this is a cruel way to kill a pet. Opponents said drowning isn't the same as torture, and that some farmers and trappers could be prosecuted under this law when they use this method to put down livestock. The House **KILLED** the bill 212-113. A YES vote **OPPOSED** making drowning an animal a felony.

(B,C,D,E) DO POLITICIANS NEED A TIME LIMIT DEBATING BOAT SPEED LIMITS? | HB162 would set a speed limit for all state lakes and rivers of 45 mph during the day and 15 mph at night. There were seven votes on this bill. These three roll calls were to determine how long — or even if — lawmakers should debate it. The first vote (B), to limit debate on the bill for an hour per side, **FAILED** 76-233. Some lawmakers who voted against this either wanted no limits or shorter limits. A YES vote **FAVORED** an hour limit on debating. The next vote (C) was to limit the debate to 20 minutes per side. That **PASSED** 190-133. A YES vote **FAVORED** less debate on the issue. (The House later reconsidered that vote) A motion (D) to lay the bill on the **TABLE FAILED** 140-198. A YES vote **OPPOSED** debating the bill (and perhaps the bill itself) at this time. The House ended up debating the bill for three hours (E). They eventually **PASSED** the bill but the Senate killed it on March 16.

SENATE

(E,F) WOODBURNING PLANT BUILDERS MUST TAKE SOME RISK | HB1690 is a bill relating to a proposal by Public Service of New Hampshire for a wood fired energy plant up in Berlin. The first vote (E) was on an amendment that would require the operator share half its losses or profits with New Hampshire ratepayers. Currently PSNH, as a regulated utility, guaranteed a 9.6 percent return on its investment, but the consumers must eat the losses as stranded costs. Supporters thought that this would enable other companies that were not utilities to fairly compete for the plant, resulting in a better deal for the ratepayer. Opponents thought that this would discourage PSNH from building the plant, resulting in a lost opportunity for jobs in the North Country. The Senate **PASSED** the bill 21-2. A YES vote **FAVORED** the PSNH swallowing any loss from the wood burning plant. The second vote (F) was on the bill itself. In addition to the above debate there was some concern over a last minute amendment to spend \$400,000 on a dental clinic in Tamworth, a measure previously rejected by the House. Supporters argued that this bill would help usher in wood fired energy plant, but opponents said that with these killer amendments, the bill would be going nowhere. The Senate **PASSED** the bill 20-3 to the House, but a compromise was never worked out, and the bill died on the May 26 deadline. A YES vote **FAVORED** the bill with its amendments.

(G) LEAVE TAX APPEAL BOARD IN THE JUDICIARY | SB390 would have the Governor and the legislature appointing the Board of Land and Tax Appeals, where res-
