HAMPTON | "It's a little bit of work, but it's a lot of fun" is how Cliff Pratt describes the effort that goes into preparing for the Hampton Historical Society's annual Southern Style Pig Roast.

There's still about a month and a half to go before the roasting pit is actually fired up for this year's event. But planning for the historical society's major fundraiser has already begun.

With co-chairmen Catherine Fletcher and Betty Moore at the helm, and Pratt once again serving as the chief in charge of the roasting duties, the festivities will take place Labor Day Weekend on Saturday, September 2 from 12-3 p.m. at the Tuck Museum on Park Avenue.

The menu will feature a succulent pork dinner with all the trimmings, including baked beans, salads, rolls and desserts. A silent auction, music, and 50-50 chances will also be part of the fun. Guests

can bring their own lawn chairs or blankets to sit upon, or they can use the tables and chairs that will be set up on the museum grounds.

Board members have already begun selling pig roast tickets at \$20 each for

adults, \$18 for members and \$10 for ages 9-16 (age 8 and under are free when accompanied by an adult). Tickets for tables of eight may be purchased for \$150. The committee is hoping to sell about 300 tickets this year; money

raised will go toward museum operations.

HHS members are also busy seeking donations of items for the silent auction, which will be conducted from 12-2:30 p.m. the day of the pig roast. Seacoast area businesses who wish to donate auction items may call (603) 929-0781 to donate, or to obtain additional information.

According to committee members, "the pig roast has been a very successful fundraiser for the Society and it is always a fun afternoon."
